Ramp Door		CargoSport comes with an optional capacity rated recessed rear ramp door, with hidden hinges, hidden wiring, rear corner post skid plates, inside hinge cover, and heavy-duty aluminum trim. The Wagon Series optional rear ramp door has exposed hinges, an outdated and unattractive design. Cargo-Sport provides two barlocks which are easier and safer to use than Wagon Series' single camlock. In addition, CargoSport provides a galvaneal flap hinge with stainless steel pin. The Wagon Series does not provide such anti-rusting features.	Shadow features a capacity rated recessed rear ramp door, with hidden hinges, hidden wiring, rear corner post skid plates, inside hinge cover, and heavy-duty aluminum trim. auto-Wagon has exposed hinges, an outdated and unattractive design. Shadow provides two barlocks which are easier and safer to use than autoWagon's single camlock.
